Women's History and Culture Center Fall Reopening

Good news! After a long summer break, the Women's Center returns to regular hours starting Tuesday September 12, open from 11 AM to 3 PM, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. At last month's Kick-Off meeting, we reviewed upcoming activities for the fall and thanked our greeters and volunteers for making the Women's Center a welcoming place for visitors and groups who hold their meetings and events here.

What's New at the Women's History and Culture Center

The new look at the Women's Center includes an expanded biography section with over 700 books about individual memorable women of all ages, accomplishments, countries, from historic times, plus another 1,000 books about groups of women, as well as topics of interest to women. The display of women on U.S. Quarters was updated with the latest 2023 mint set.

New educational initiatives planned for the coming year are an outreach program for K to 2^{nd} grade readers, and a speaker's program for older youth. Eighty books from the Young Readers section are now earmarked for the K to 2^{nd} grade program, and a data base for the speaker's program is in its development stage. 
